Finland is a great place to found a PropTech startup. In 2019 PropTech Finland was officially launched, with the main focus on building a community for the PropTech startups and scaleups. The Built Environment industry is taking small steps forward by investing more time and money to boost its digitalization maturity. A number of PropTech companies in Finland have raised from around 90 to nearly 150 startups, thanks to the updated Startup map. Some of PropTech Finland members like GBuilder with its solution for residential developers has expanded and now has clients in 7 countries and over 15,000 homes on their platform. Assetti joined emerging ecosystems around Europe, such as BuiltAPI and Platform of Trust. Finland aims to keep its leading position in innovation in the built environment.





